

## Jordan's Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR)

- During the reporting period 1,247 deaths among women of reproductive age were notified through the JMMSR Information System (JMMSR IS).
- A total of 62 maternal deaths were identified from these.
- A total number of 207,917 live births for the same period.



### Jordan's Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR)

#### • Jordan's Maternal Mortality Ratio was calculated at 29.8 per 100,000 live births




#### **Maternal Deaths by Parity**

#### **Maternal Deaths by Timing of Death**







#### **JMMSR System Responses**

- Adopt strategies for the prevention and management of obstetric hemorrhage.
- Adopt strategies to reduce cases of venous thromboembolism.
- Adopt strategies to enhance the quality of antenatal care services.
- Reduce unnecessary primary cesarean section deliveries.
- Increase the uptake of quality family planning methods.
